## About Us

All of our courses are tailored to your needs and are inclusive of all the latest motorcycle safety gear, to include helmet, jacket, trousers, boots, gloves and waterproofs. We use the latest reliable, proven quality, Japanese motorcycles, and all training is carried out in the safety of our purpose built fully equipped school with its own 12,000 sq ft tarmac area, all on road tuition is conducted on a maximum of a 2:1 basis.

## Compulsory Basic Training (C.B.T.) †

If you can already ride a manual motorcycle or just wish to ride an automatic scooter, then a C.B.T course is designed with you in mind. It should be noted that it is not a test, but merely basic training that will let you ride as a learner on L-Plates for up to two years once you have shown that you are safe and competent. It is also the first step before moving on to taking a full licence.

(Maximum of 125cc on L-plates unaccompanied)



## New Rider Course (N.R.C) †

Our unique New Rider Courses are designed specifically for complete beginners or anyone who wishes to learn how to ride a manual motorcycle with no pressure about having to perform in front of large groups.

This course is two hours long and is run strictly on a one student to one Instructor ratio.



## Motorcycle Theory Test †

This is a prerequisite before being allowed to book any kind of full motorcycle licence. The motorcycle theory test comprises of multiple choice questions, currently 43 out of 50 must be marked as correct to reach the pass standard and with the Hazard perception videos you must score at least 44 out of 75.

This can be booked through us, where we will supply a new up to date copy of the Highway Code with all available test spaces. We also stock all of the official Driving Standards Agency learning materials.

## Standard Bike Licence (A2)

If you are under 21 or just wish to ride small capacity motorcycles or scooters (less than 33BHP) then this is the test for you.

All of the training will be done on a 125cc motorcycle or scooter. Upon passing the Driving Standards Agency Test, you can then ride a bike of any size but it must be limited to 25kwh (33 BHP). You are allowed to carry passengers and ride on motorways. After having this licence for two years, it will automatically upgrade to enable you to then ride any size, or power, output motorcycle or scooter.

## Return to Biking (B2B) †

The back to biking day has been designed so that no matter how long ago you passed your test or how long it has been since you were last on a motorcycle, you can be guaranteed of a tuition package that will let you re-learn the skills you require on our off road area before venturing out on to the public road. This will generally start on a 125cc before moving up to either 500/600 cc bike.

## Direct Access Scheme (D.A.S.)

Riders over 21 years of age only, can participate in D.A.S. This will usually start on the smaller machines for the initial stages of your training, unless you are already an experienced rider, before moving onto a motorcycle that produces at least 35kwh (approximately 47 BHP). Upon passing the Driving Standards Agency Test you may ride a motorcycle or scooter of any size or power output.



## Enhanced Rider Scheme (E.R.S.) †

Why spend all your money on your bike? It is amazing how much money is spent on making them look better, go faster and stop quicker?

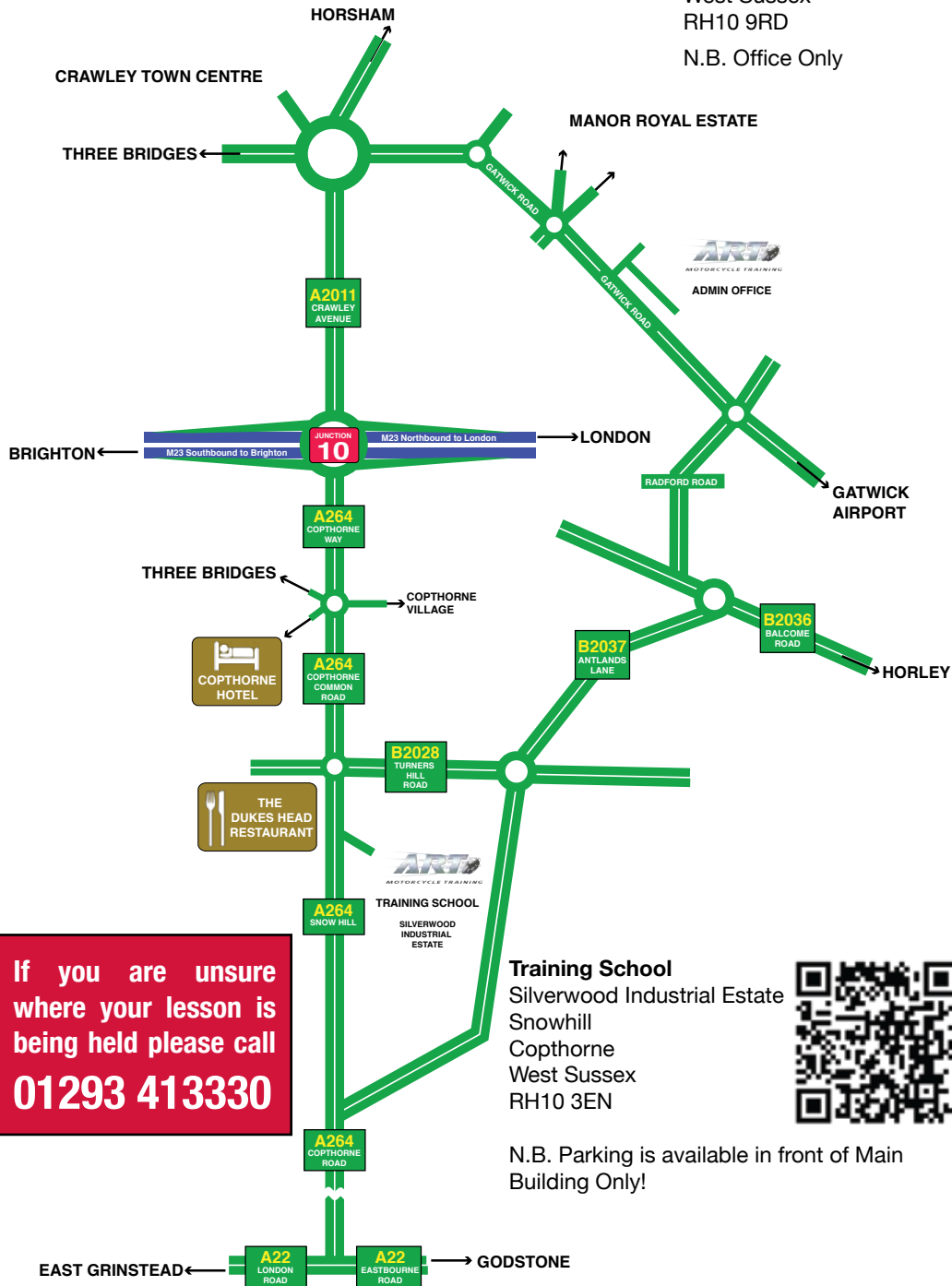
The single biggest improvement you can make is to the skill of the rider, this will be carried from bike to bike and won't depreciate in price!

The ERS syllabus is Driving Standards Agency approved and can only be delivered by registered, qualified, insured professionals who are on the register of Post Licence Motorcycle trainers. (R.P.M.T) once an E.R.S certificate is issued it will gain you up to 20% discount on your next renewal, and you will be safe in the knowledge that you are a better, safer rider.
